Pastor's Column

Spring is here! Winter has gone, and we are enjoying warm breezes. We are seeing all different kinds of flowers blooming, including the bluebonnet. We are very excited to see bluebonnets soon during our bus trip! As you know, the bluebonnet is the state flower of Texas. Its name was chosen because the shape of the petals on the flower resembles the sunbonnet worn by people to shield themselves from the sun. It seems to be a perfect name for the Texas summer.

The bluebonnet is not just one species. The original state flower was Lupinus subcarnosus (Sandyland or Texas bluebonnet). The bill approving it as the state flower was signed on March 7, 1901, by Gov. Joseph D. Sayers. The debate then continued for 70 years, as there were a number of other species of bluebonnet native to Texas. On March 8, 1971, the Legislature amended the 1901 statute to include Lupinus texensis (Texas bluebonnet) "and any other variety of bluebonnet not heretofore recorded." Essentially, all bluebonnets found in Texas are now considered the official flower of the state.

God created the world and is continuously creating. That is why we can see all different kinds of flowers, trees, and animals. They make our world beautiful. As we grow, we will see all different kinds of people in the church. They will make our church beautiful. All people found in Christ should be considered the children of God. We are called to love, teach, and embrace them. However, we may need to re-focus on our current strategies to reach out to new people, just as the Texas Legislature amended the definition of the bluebonnet.

As we enter the season of renewal and growth, I would like to invite you to the new sermon series called "Re-Focus." We will journey together with the story of Noah described in Genesis 6-9, exploring how he re-focused on his faith during the terrific flood. This series will offer you a beacon of hope and inspire a renewed sense of purpose and faith in your life. I hope you will join us as we rediscover our spiritual path and refocus on our hearts and minds.
