Pastor's Column

We are in the season of Lent. Lent is a season of forty days, not counting Sundays, which begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Saturday, which is the Saturday before Easter Sunday. During Lent, we focus on praying and fasting, while we remember Christ's public ministry, suffering, death on the cross, and resurrection. In other words, It is a time to draw closer to God, seeking God's presence and guidance as we prepare our hearts for the celebration of Christ's triumphant resurrection.

One of the most powerful prayers we can turn to during this season is the Lord's Prayer. It is a prayer which our Lord taught us. It is a prayer which has been inherited from early Christians. It is not merely a prayer to be recited during Sunday worship services but a model for how to pray. The Lord's Prayer serves as a spiritual anchor in our life. It reminds us that our God in heaven is holy and sovereign. It realigns our hearts to seek the kingdom of God rather than our own desires. It humbles us to ask for our daily needs, both physical and spiritual, and it strengthens us to resist temptation.

As we explore the Lord's Prayer that Jesus gave us, I hope that you will be closer to God. Let us embrace this season as an opportunity to pray more intentionally, allowing the Lord's Prayer to shape our hearts and lead us into a closer walk with Christ.

May this Lenten season be a time of renewal, drawing us into the presence of God through the gift of prayer.

- There are three bids to fix roof leak in the foyer of Wesley Hall. The board decided to use Murhead roofing to fix it. Its estimated cost is \$4,760. They will request the permanent endowment committee to discuss this matter.

• The permanent endowment committee met on March 9 and approved to use funds from Permanent endowment fund gain/loss to fix the roof leak.


