As we enter April, I would like you to join this season of hope, renewal, and resurrection. We will celebrate Easter together as a church family! Easter Sunday reminds us that the grave could not hold our Savior. Jesus Christ Is Risen Indeed! And because He lives, we have hope beyond this life and strength for each new day.

This month, as we rejoice in the power of the resurrection, we're also beginning a new sermon series on the book of Jonah. You may wonder how the story of Jonah will connect to the Easter story. But as you follow Jonah's journey, you will find yourselves who are called to follow our Risen Christ wherever He leads. It is a tough call because our journey can be marked by running, resisting, repenting, and ultimately being redeemed just as Jonah did.

Jonah's story teaches us powerful life lessons. God's call is often unexpected and sometimes challenged. However, it is a great opportunity for us to experience God's mercy as we respond to the call. God's purposes will prevail even when we try to go our own way. As we walk through this series, we'll explore what it means to live a life shaped by grace and obedience, fueled by the truth that Christ is risen and reigning.

I encourage you to enjoy this season beyond a simple celebration of an empty tomb. Let it be a time of personal renewal and recommitment. Whether you're in the belly of a storm, running from God, or returning to God, there is always room at the foot of the cross and a fresh start because of the power of resurrection.

Christ is risen indeed! And because He is risen, we can rise too, into purpose, into calling, and into the abundant life He promises.


Easter Breakfast sponsored by the Women's Guild will be served at 9:00 a.m., before worship service.

FHUMC Board of Directors Report

The Board met on March 24th. The following is an outline of the meeting:

- Developing the balcony of the sanctuary is still waiting for the city's approval, only 1 departments approval is still needed.
- It was decided to open a claim on the storm damage the Church as well as the parsonage sustained during on March 7th.
- A 12 month Covenant agreement between FHUMC and MercyPrep was approved with the addition of 2 classrooms (resource room and the old kitchen).
- The container remodel went ahead as planned and approved at the last meeting.



We would definitely like to thank MercyPrep as well as the Board for spearheading this remodel. This upgrades to the container will continue to benefit us for years to come.



A small fan was installed to help ventilate the container to help alleviate moisture build up.





As you can see electricity has been routed to the container and throughout the interior of the container. This allowed us to install new lighting fixture inside as well as make the newly installed ventilation fan operational.

When: May 2-3, 2025 from 3:00 p.m. on Friday to 2:00 p.m. on Saturday


Where: Lakeview Camp and Retreat Center in Waxahachie, TX
